Heightened Cleaning and Disinfection Protocols



Boise Centre is adhering to CDC and GBAC guidance for cleaning and disinfection. Cleaning protocols and frequency have increased with an emphasis on highly visited areas such as restrooms, event spaces, elevators, and escalators.

Temperature Checks



Everyone entering Boise Centre will be screened for temperatures utilizing thermal monitoring cameras. Anyone displaying a temperature at or above 100.3 F will be taken to a private area for a secondary screening. Persons confirmed to have a temperature at or above 100.3 F will not be permitted to enter.

Personal Protective Equipment



Boise Centre adheres to the recommendations of state and local health authorities. Central District Health issued a mandatory face mask order on July 14, 2020 and all Boise Centre employees wear face masks. Individuals entering the facility are also required to wear a face mask or covering.

Catering



Front & Centre, exclusive in-house catering for Boise Centre, has created service standards for high quality and guest safety. All catering and bar services are available.

Hand Sanitizers



Alcohol-based hand sanitizer dispensers, touchless whenever possible, and sanitation stations are placed throughout the venue.
